We've educated 180 first responders in Kentucky and Southern Indiana on the effects of carcinogen-causing gases from fires and the need for proper protection to avoid more cases of cancer.

Genetic Testing Legislation



Beginning in January 2020, testing for hereditary cancers (including colon, pancreatic, gastric, breast, ovarian, endometrial, pancreatic, prostate, melanoma, and others) for people who meet national guidelines for testing will be completely covered by private insurance in Kentucky as a preventative service, thanks to a new law that was passed by the General Assembly.
